

# Abeilles sauvages

La Diversité des Abeilles Sauvages Les abeilles sauvages regroupent plusieurs milliers d'espèces à travers le monde, et en France, plus de 1 000 espèces ont été recensées. Elles varient énormément en taille, en apparence, en comportement et en habitat.

Les Principales Familles d'Abeilles Sauvages

1. Augochlorini : Abeilles vertes et métalliques, souvent solitaires.
2. Andrenidae : Abeilles de sol, très répandues dans les régions tempérées.
3. Apidae (sauf *Apis mellifera*) : Inclut des abeilles sociales comme les bourdons.
