3. Tétanos

Enfermedad causada por la bacteria *Clostridium tetani*, que entra al organismo a través de heridas o heridas contaminadas. Síntomas: - Rigidez muscular, especialmente en la mandíbula (trismo) -

Espasmos musculares generalizados - Dificultad para tragar - Dificultad respiratoria Tratamiento y prevención: - Administración de antitoxina tetánica - Antibioterapia - Limpieza y desinfección de heridas - Vacunación preventiva

Enfermedades parasitarias

Los parásitos internos y externos representan una amenaza constante para la salud del caballo, afectando su rendimiento y bienestar.

1. Parasitos internos (gusanos)

Enfermedades respiratorias

1. Enfermedad pulmonar obstructiva crónica (EPOC)

También conocida como enfisema alérgico, es una reacción inflamatoria a alérgenos en el ambiente. 2. Neumonía

Enfermedades musculoesqueléticas

El sistema musculoesquelético del caballo es vulnerable a diversas lesiones y enfermedades

degenerativas.

1. Laminitis (inflamación de la lámina)
